

Poster-Size Poster format: Portrait A0 (H x B = 1189 mm x 841 mm): max H 1300 mm

Each poster board has got a number.

Materials to mount the posters will be available at the conference office.

Please do not print on the poster board.

Poster Format:

Your poster should have a Title, Author(s) name, Institution (to be placed at the top of the poster area, the size of the letters should be minimum 25 mm).

The letters should be 1 cm high and graph lines should be 1mm minimum.

Poster(s) should be readable at a distance of at least 2 meters.

In General:

Because of the reason that the conference is an international meeting we may ask you to present your poster in English.

Posters should be intelligible in themselves, even in the absence of the authors and without a study of the abstract.

Please structure your poster as follows:

- 1) Title, Author(s), Institution
- 2) Introduction
Background information, purpose of study
- 3) Results
- 4) Discussion and Conclusion
An interpretation of the results and their significance

Copies of a summary of your work or copies of the poster should be posted in the upper left hand corner of the poster board.
